A. How to do headhunting?

- 1. As a campus headhunter, you can act on your own and scout for any high school students who are interested in robotics with critical thinking and independent research and developing abilities, especially those who had competition experience (about robot, information and algorism). Recommend your target students to enter the official website www.robomaster.com, go to RoboMaster Robotics Camps and click RoboMaster Robotics Winter Camp (High School) to register for the RoboMaster 2019 Robotics Summer Camp.
- 2. During registration, students are required to enter the **full name of their headhunters** in the **registration system** (the name of a headhunter should be real, and if more than one name is entered, the first one prevails). After students have successfully registered and admitted to the summer camp, the final points of headhunters will be calculated accordingly.
- 3. Awards will be announced after a headhunter list is published on official forum (bbs.robomaster.com), and then RoboMaster staff will actively contact winners to deliver prizes.
